Support the BULLDOG FAMILY FUND



The Irvington PTSA established the Bulldog Family Fund (BFF) to ensure that every student in our District has access to the same opportunities and experiences as their peers. The BFF provides financial support to students whose families are income eligible for free or reduced lunch (FRL), or in temporary financial need.



One in 12 students in our school district are income eligible for FRL. In New York State, eligibility for FRL translates to an annual income of between \$39,000 and \$55,000 for a family of four.

Every year, the BFF spends up to \$50,000 to fulfill requests from families.

Here's a snapshot of what the BFF covers:
